JAST is published twice each year in March and November. Each issue will include the following sections: editorial, research papers, book reviews, conference reports, and industry viewpoints.

A range of papers is encouraged, including evidence-based research papers, reviews, personal reflections. In addition to research-based papers, we welcome papers on industrial perspectives for the "Industrial Issues" section of the journal.

Papers accepted for publication will be assigned to the March or November issue at the discretion of the Editorial Board.

Journal Article Preparation Guidelines for Prospective Author(s)

Any writing style (APA, MLA, Chicago, etc.) may be used based on Author(s) discipline.

Author(s) should use Calibri, 1.5 or 2.0 spacing in MS Word document, and 12-point font, and left align.

- **Title page** (The front page of the paper should include: title of the paper, name, affiliation, postal address, and email for each Author.
- **Abstract** (should be no longer than 250 words, and should summarize the research problem and its significance, the methodology used, key findings, analysis and interpretation of the findings, and conclusion.
- **Keywords**
- **Introduction** (background, rationale, purpose of the study, research objectives, research questions, hypothesis, etc.)
- **Body of Paper**
 - **Methods** research design, data collection, procedures, data analysis, reliability and validity, ethical issues considered, etc.)
 - **Results** discuss major findings according to research questions/objectives with the literature, support or refute findings, alternative interpretations, study limitations)
 - **Conclusion** (concluding remarks on major findings and recommendations, etc.)
- **Tables**, charts, mathematical copy: Tables should be submitted on separate pages with their preferred position in the text clearly indicated (Microsoft Excel is the preferred choice). Charts must be prepared in black and white. Mathematical copy must be clearly set out and correctly aligned.
- **Illustrations/Figures:** These should be provided in high-resolution digital form (minimum 300 DPI), as separate JPEGs, and should be clearly captioned. Authors are responsible for obtaining reproduction permission for such materials as required.
- **References** in discipline-appropriate style
- **Acknowledgements** (optional)
- **Appendices** (optional)
- **Biodata** (Each author should submit a brief profile indicating highest qualifications, institution to which attached, and areas of research interests)

Paper Review Process

- Receive and acknowledge to the Author(s) receipt of the paper.
- Review paper (Each paper will be peer reviewed by at least two experts in the field for originality, significance, clarity, impact, and soundness, etc.)
- Remarks (paper may be rejected or accepted, or the author(s) may be asked to revise paper, etc.)
- Author(s) notified, will be asked to send in bio-data if not previously submitted.
- Paper published (Publication is in March and November of each year)

Note:

- Journal articles (submission should not be more than 6,000 words)
- Industrial perspectives from professionals in Industry (submission should be at least 600 words)
